Update on a Centralised Administration System (CAS)

A recent Government decision approved the progression of work on the design of a centralised administration system (CAS) for the Single Scheme to support Relevant Authorities in the administration of the Single Scheme.

DPER, along with Revenue and the Department of Social Protection is collaborating on delivering the technical centralised administration solution. DPER has also commenced work on drafting the legislation required to underpin the collection and processing of relevant data necessary.

DPER is actively engaging with stakeholders across the Public Sector and intends to engage with Relevant Authority representatives later this year. We will issue further updates in due course as both progress on the legislation, and stakeholder collaboration continues.
