Single Scheme Policy Developments Circular 12 of 2019 – Vesting

DPER <u>Circular 12 of 2019</u> "Guidance on the Vesting Period in the Single Public Service Pension Scheme" issued to all Relevant Authorities on 30 May. This Circular provides clarification on the measurement and operation of the vesting period in the Single Scheme. In particular, this Circular clarifies the treatment of paid / unpaid leave, atypical employments and simultaneous employments in measuring a Single Scheme member's progress towards completing the Scheme 24 month vesting period. Circular 15 of 2019 – Purchase and Transfer

DPER <u>Circular 15 of 2019</u> "Purchase and Transfer of Retirement Benefits under the Single Public Service Pension Scheme" issued to all Relevant Authorities on 12 June along with the associated regulations made under <u>S.I. No. 252 of 2019</u>. This Circular provides details of the Single Scheme purchase facility which is due to come into effect from **1 October 2019**. This Circular also provides a means for potentially facilitating the transfer of pension benefits held by a member employed *outside of the public service* while a member of a Revenue approved pension arrangement.

Town Hall Event on 18 June

Thank you to everyone who attended the Single Scheme Town Hall event held in Dublin on the 18 June. Almost 300 people attended, indicating the high level of interest in the topics presented, which included:

- An overview of recent project progress;
- An update on Databank Onboarding (see below);
- An outline of the Pensions Authority role and responsibilities;
- An overview of the Actuarial Review of Public Service Pensions, which will involve a data request being issued to all public service bodies in the next few weeks;
- Details on the Single Scheme Purchase/Transfer Policy.

Single Scheme Databank

As noted at the recent Town Hall event (details above), the Single Scheme Databank is due to go live in the coming weeks and, once operational, bodies will be onboarded in waves.

Two data templates (Scheme Files) must be populated and uploaded to the Databank for **each Relevant Authority** for **each year:**

- a Membership Data File; and
- a Benefits Payment Data Scheme File

The **final versions** of these data templates, and associated resources, were circulated by e-mail to all relevant authorities on 28 May. These may be accessed at www.singlepensionscheme.gov.ie/databank, the content of which will be further enhanced in the coming weeks once the Databank goes live including the publication of a Databank Privacy Notice. At this time, all bodies should be continuing to progress the preparation of Scheme Files for each year since 2013 pending a request from DPER to onboard to the Databank.

The project team has had initial engagements with all bodies that have kindly agreed to participate in wave 1 in advance of the scheduling of Databank training. If you are interested in your organisation being considered for onboarding to the Databank in an early wave, please make contact with us by emailing singleschemequeries@per.gov.ie.

Training Workshops

The Project Team completed delivery of 12 Single Scheme Training Workshops covering Modules B&C: Leaving Single Scheme Employment and Annual Administration Activities and Module A: Recruitment and Onboarding activities over March to May. Training was delivered to a total of 251 attendees from 125 Relevant Authorities. Copies of the material can be found here.
